CPA ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 01-2010

TO : **All Department, Division Managers, Shipping Lines and Others Concerned**

SUBJECT : **Mandatory Weighing of All Outbound Loaded Container Vans at the Baseport of Cebu**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.A. No. 7621, the General Port Rules and Regulations (GPRR) of the Cebu Port Authority, the Philippine Dockwork Health and Safety Standards, OTS Transportation Security Regulation No. 011-2007 (*Mandatory Compliance of the Required Security Assessment and Security Plan of Ships and Port / Shipyard / Offshore Platform Drilling Facilities Covered by the National Security Programme for Sea Transport and Maritime Infrastructure [NSPSTMI]*) to ensure safety in the handling of outbound containers and mitigate risks to port facilities, cargo handling equipment and carrying vessels, and pursuant to Board Resolution No. 500-2010 dated 08 June 2010, the following policy and implementing guidelines on the mandatory weighing of outbound domestic container vans to be loaded at the Cebu Baseport, are hereby prescribed:

Section 1. Statement of Policy

It is hereby the declared policy of the Authority that all loaded outbound domestic container vans shall be required to undergo a weighing process to ensure the safety of workers in cargo handling and equipment and the carrying vessel itself.

Section 2. Coverage

This mandatory policy covers all loaded outbound domestic container vans to be loaded at the Cebu Baseport.

Section 3. Guidelines

The following guidelines are hereby prescribed:
